

How to download library eBooks for

Instructions:

1. Go to the Hoover Public Library Website: <http://www.hooverlibrary.org/> and click on the 'eBooks & Downloadable Audiobooks'. This will open the JCLC downloadable content page.
2. Login before searching to see eBooks available only to the Hoover Public library! Click 'Login,' and enter your library card number (with no spaces).
3. To see the entire list of Kindle eBooks, click the "Now Available, Library eBooks for Kindle" logo on the left-hand side of the Web page. (Otherwise you may use the search function to search for a specific title.)
4. Check the box 'Only show titles with copies available,' and click the 'Submit' button if you want something to check out immediately. Otherwise leave the box unchecked to find all available titles, including those with waiting lists. Note: For classics that never expire, click 'Additional eBooks Always Available' at bottom-left-side of the page.
5. Choose a book. Next to Kindle Book, click 'Add to Cart' link.
6. Click 'Proceed to Check Out.'
7. Choose your desired lending period (7, 14 or 21 days).
8. Click 'Confirm Check Out.'
9. Click 'Get for Kindle.' This will take you to the Amazon.com website.
10. Click 'Get Library Book.'
11. Sign in with your Amazon.com account information or create an account if you don't have one.
12. Choose where you want the eBook to be downloaded (device or reading app).
13. Click 'Continue.' The eBook will appear on your device as soon as it connects to the Internet.

Note: Public library eBooks require an active Wi-Fi connection for wireless delivery to a Kindle device. Library eBooks cannot be delivered via the Kindle's 3G connection. If you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, you may load your library eBook to a device via USB. (See below).

Downloading via USB – follow steps 1-13, then...

14. Connect your Kindle to your computer with your USB cord.
15. Click 'Download Now.'
16. Click 'Save.'
17. When prompted for a save location, go to 'My Computer' and double click the 'Kindle' drive.
18. Double click the 'Documents' folder.
19. Click 'Save.'
20. In 'My Computer,' right click on 'Kindle' drive and click 'Eject' to safely remove the Kindle.
