

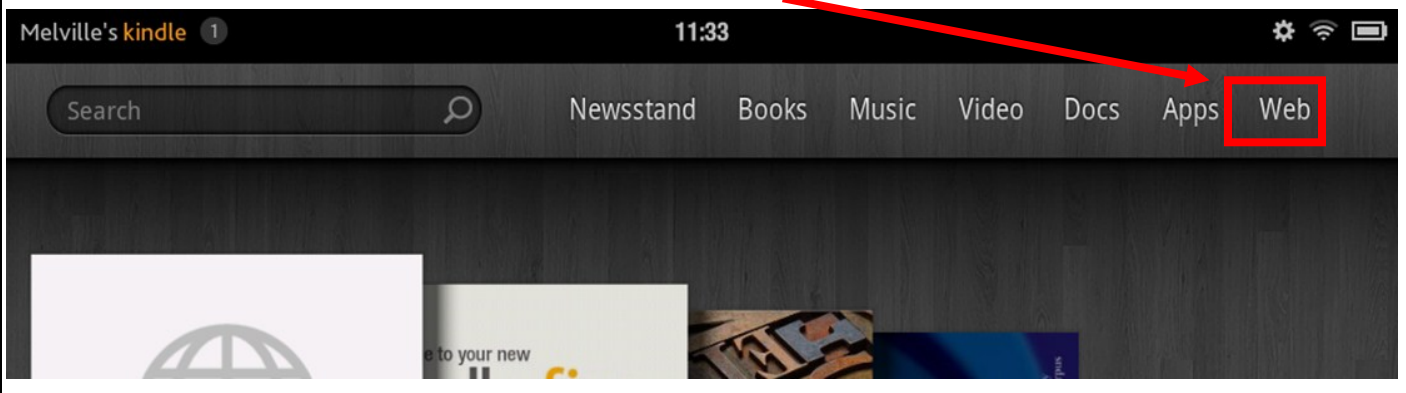
# Using your Kindle Fire with the Hoover Public Library

## What you'll need:

- **A Kindle Fire**
- **An Amazon.com account** (If you purchased your Kindle through Amazon, you should already have one. Otherwise, you'll need to visit [www.amazon.com](http://www.amazon.com) and create an account).

## Step 1: Check out your ebook.

Open the Kindle Fire Web browser by selecting 'Web' from the 'Home' page.



Click the "eBooks" link on the [www.hooverlibrary.org](http://www.hooverlibrary.org) website

OR

Go to the JCLC Downloadables website at <http://downloadable.jclc.org>.



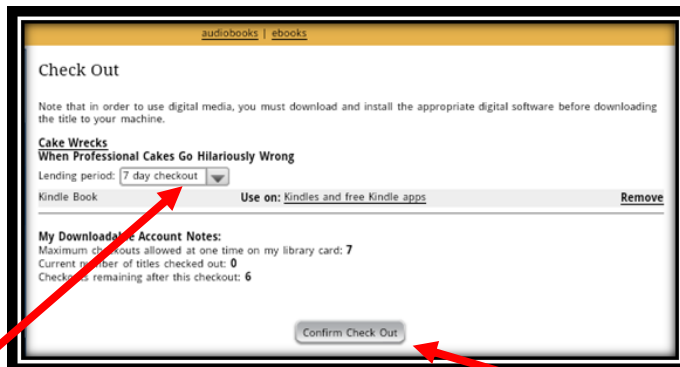
If you have a Hoover Public Library card, it is recommended that you log in to your account through the JCLC's Downloadable website (<http://downloadable.jclc.org>) BEFORE you search or browse for ebooks. Hoover Public Library has an Advantage account which provides access to additional titles which may not be visible unless you sign in with a Hoover Public Library card.



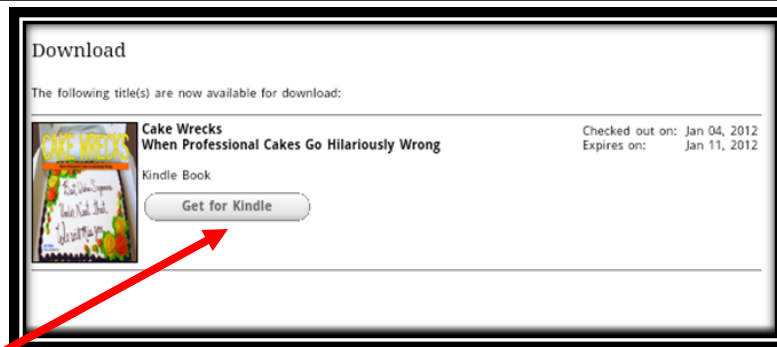
Select the ebook by clicking 'Add to Cart' beside the 'Kindle Book' option.



Click 'Proceed to Checkout' (if you've finished selecting books).

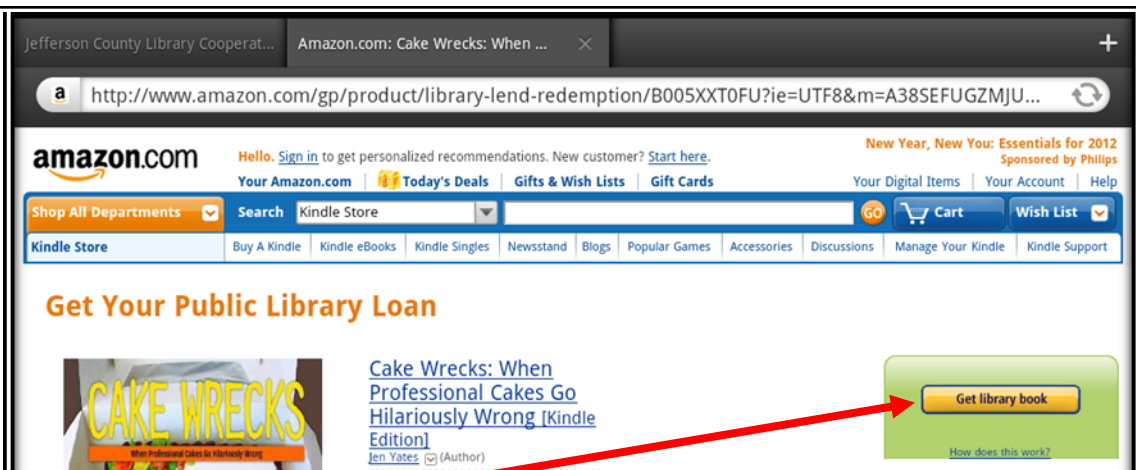


Select how long you'd like to check out the book and click the 'Confirm Check Out' button.



Click 'Get for Kindle.' This will redirect you to the Amazon page to receive your ebook.

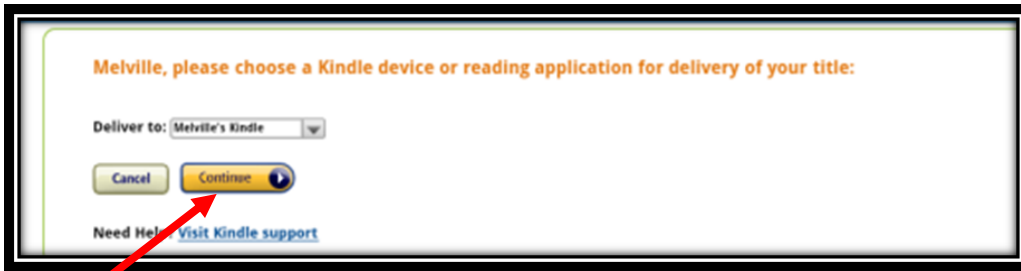
## Step 2: Send the ebook to your Kindle Fire through your Amazon account.



Click 'Get Library book.'

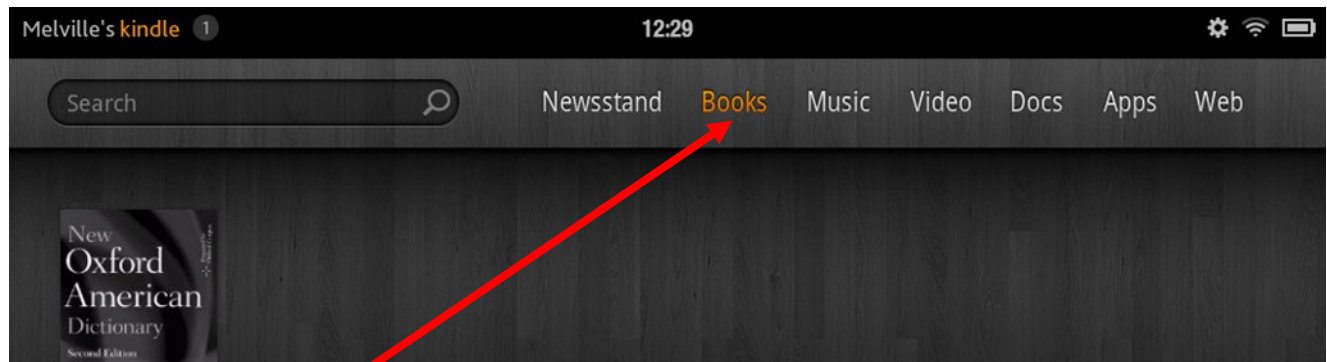


You'll be prompted to log in to your Amazon.com account if you haven't already.



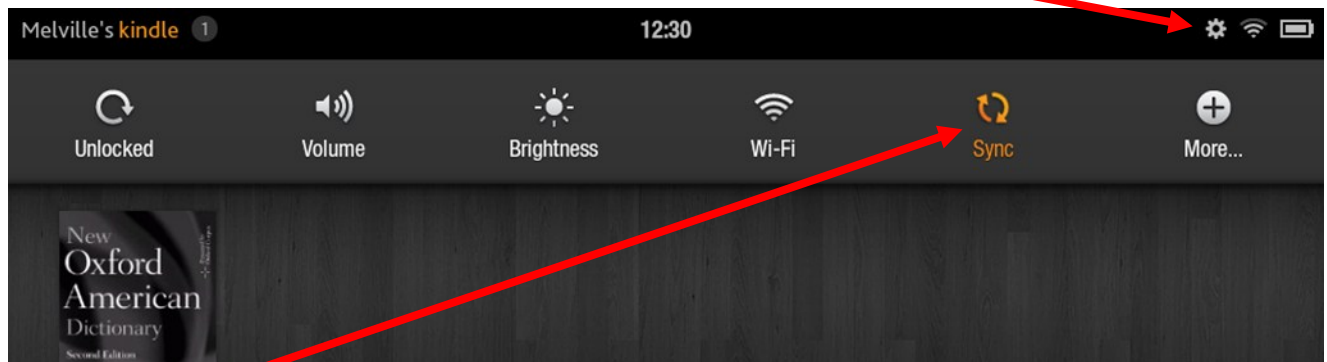
Deliver your library ebook to your Kindle Fire.

### Step 3: View your book in the 'Books' app.



Select 'Books' on the 'Home' menu.

If your book does not show up immediately, click on the 'Gear' icon in the top-right corner of the 'Home' screen.



Select 'Sync.' Your book should download and appear on the shelf.
