Hoover Veterans Committee Membership Criteria

1. Membership shall not exceed 19 members including a committee chair, ten members appointed by the committee chair and eight members selected at large from the City of Hoover.
2. The mayor and city council members do not count toward the 19 members.
3. The ten appointed members shall be selected by the committee chair and be representative of all services: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines and Coast Guard, with at least one representative from each service.
4. Committee chair appointed military members would be active duty military personnel or military veterans released from duty with an Honorable Discharge.
5. The eight members at large shall include representation from the Hoover Chamber of Commerce, Hoover Library, Hoover Beautification Board, Hoover Fire Department, Hoover Police Department, Hoover city schools, Hoover Public Works and New Horizons.
6. Newly appointed members shall be approved by at least a two-thirds vote of the existing committee membership.
7. The Mayor of the City of Hoover has veto authority on all appointments.
8. The term for committee members shall be from their time of appointment until the end of the mayor's elective term.
9. New committee membership will be considered the month following the mayoral inauguration or as deemed necessary by the Veterans Committee Chair, but only in compliance with committee structure as outlined above.
10. New membership will not be considered until the month following the mayoral election unless circumstances necessitate as defined by the committee chair.
